

# OVAL RULES

(Reviewed January 2013)

1. Shoes will be worn at all times.
2. Students will not take school bags, food, drink or paper onto the oval.  
Personal water bottles are permitted.
3. There will be **NO** tackling, bumping or rough play.
4. Classes use their own equipment on the oval
5. Students are expected to play within their own age groups.
6. The oval is out of bounds when it is raining.

## CONSEQUENCES

### Positive

When students RESPECT and follow the OVAL RULES then there will be:

- Safe play for all involved (fewer injuries)
- A fair go for all students
- The oval remains a safe place for all students to play on
- There will be no damage to expensive school uniform clothing.

### Negative

When students do not RESPECT and follow the OVAL RULES then this behaviour is assessed as inappropriate or unacceptable.

Inappropriate: students will be asked to leave the oval.

- This will mean that you do not play on the oval or do the activity you were involved in for the rest of that day and the following day.
- Your name will be recorded in the school day book for each day you are restricted from the oval.
- Staff will fill on a Behaviour Intervention slip and the incident will be recorded on DUX.

### Unacceptable (Red Rule)

Where inappropriate oval behaviour is repeated three times in a term then it is deemed to be **unacceptable** and students will receive at least a one week ban from the oval and the activity.

They may also:

- receive a yard focus room referral
- be required to undertake yard community service
- be banned from the oval for longer periods of time.
